

Respectful Relationships Coalition Video Contest

Mentor Guidelines

Teens aged 13-18 are invited to create a video promoting healthy relationships and interactions. This can focus on many different areas and issues, including: bullying, cyberbullying, friendships, and dating relationships. Any group submitting a video should have contacted or attended a presentation by educators from Crime Victim Center and/or SafeNet prior to the creation of the video. The contest will begin September 15, 2011, with submissions being accepted until 4pm December 15. Each group is required to have an adult mentor working with them.

1. Mentors may not be employees of Respectful Relationships Coalition agencies.
2. Mentor must read and review the contest Terms and Conditions.
3. Mentor may not create the video. Suggestions may be given for editing, but may not directly influence content creation or video recording. If needed, engage in conversations with the teens to help them come up with their own ideas, or refer them to the resource list for inspiration.
4. Mentors should remember this is meant to be a fun, *voluntary* project for teens unless part of a school assignment.
5. Mentor should view the video before submission to check for unacceptable content.
